

Typical issues in the critical thinking process

- 1. Analysis: the ability to gather and process knowledge and information.
- **2. Interpretation**: drawing conclusions about the meaning of collected information.
- **3.** Inference: Judging whether knowledge is sufficient and reliable.
- 4. Evaluation: the ability to make decisions based on the information available.
- 5. Explanation: the ability to prepare, share and communicate knowledge and information in an understandable way.
- **6. Self-regulation**: the ability to critically question one's own way of thinking.
- 7. Open-mindedness: the consideration of other perspectives and points of view.
