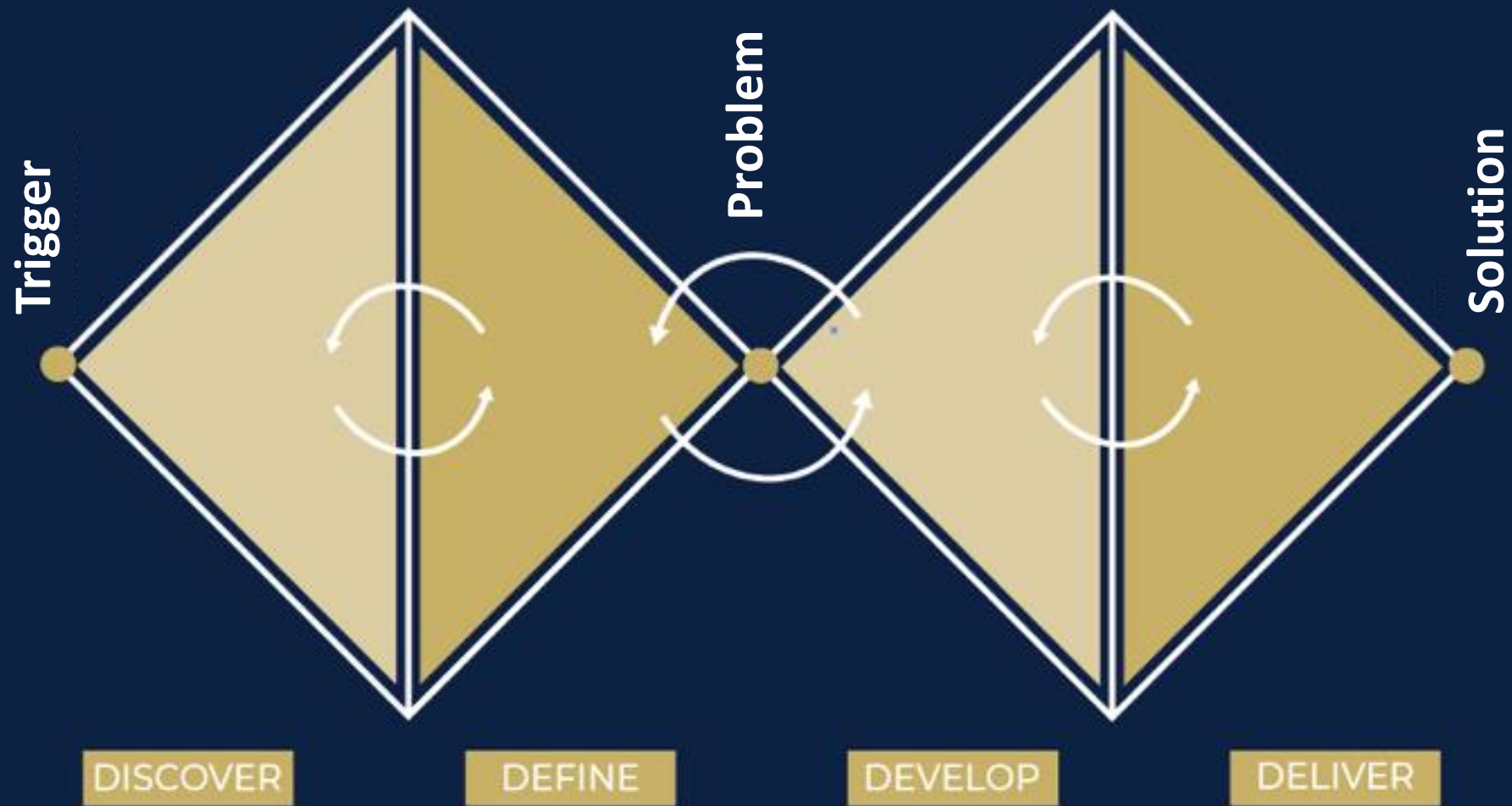

Typical issues in the critical thinking process

1. **Analysis:** the ability to gather and process knowledge and information.
2. **Interpretation:** drawing conclusions about the meaning of collected information.
3. **Inference:** Judging whether knowledge is sufficient and reliable.
4. **Evaluation:** the ability to make decisions based on the information available.
5. **Explanation:** the ability to prepare, share and communicate knowledge and information in an understandable way.
6. **Self-regulation:** the ability to critically question one's own way of thinking.
7. **Open-mindedness:** the consideration of other perspectives and points of view.
